Additional Transfer Requirements

Transfer applicants must meet all College of Liberal Arts requirements in order to be considered for admission to the Department of Communication (minimum of 24 graded transferable hours, with at least a 3.0 GPA at the time of application).

Transfer applicants should have completed a full semester course load of 12 transferable hours (minimum) after graduating from high school.

Additional Information

The Department of Communication is looking for students who are interested in pursuing our degree as a focus. Students should indicate our department as the primary major they are interested in if they wish to be admitted. Supporting materials should reflect that the student is interested in pursuing our degree.

Second-choice majors are considered.

Additionally students should have at least one semester in which 12 hours were completed in a semester.

Applications should be limited only to those students who are serious about earning a degree in Telecommunication Media Studies. Transfer applicants are instructed NOT to accept transfer admission to any major with the expectation of later applying for an on-campus change of major.

* Transferability of MATH 1324 may depend on the institution in which it was taken. As of fall 2014, MATH 1324 from some community colleges will NOT count as MATH 141 at Texas A&M University. As of fall 2016, some MATH 1324 classes transfer as MATH 140. Some MATH 1324 classes transfer as MATH 141. For this degree, make certain that the MATH 1324 selected is equivalent to MATH 141.

The safe options for the Mathematics requirement are MATH 1332 and PHIL 2303. Take these instead of MATH 1324.

Transfer applicants are encouraged to complete [University Core Curriculum](#) coursework found in the [Undergraduate Catalog](#).

Students are recommended to begin their foreign language before applying to transfer if their home institution offers the language they intend to use. Two years, 14 hours, of the same foreign language is required to complete the degree.

Transfer Course Sheet Notes

1. ENGL 1301 is accepted for ENGL 104 if completed prior to fall 2014.
2. Admission preference is given to applicants with the highest GPA and the most appropriate courses completed.
