Applicants should be serious about earning a degree in University Studies. Transfer applicants are instructed NOT to accept transfer admission to any major with the expectation of later applying for an on-campus change of major.

Students pursuing a bachelor of arts are recommended to begin their foreign language before applying to transfer if their home institution offers the language they intend to use. Two years, 14 hours, of the same foreign language is required to complete the bachelor of arts degree.

Transfer Course Sheet Notes

1. ENGL 1301 is accepted for ENGL 104 if completed prior to fall 2014.
2. MATH 1324 from some institutions will not be a direct equivalent to MATH 141 at Texas A&M University but will satisfy the core math requirement for this major.
3. Admission preference is given to applicants with the highest GPA and the most appropriate courses completed.
4. This Transfer Course Sheet was supported in a partnership between The Office of Admissions and College of Liberal Arts at Texas A&M University with the Undergraduate Catalog having the most extant and definitive information.

Additional Transfer Requirements

Transfer applicants must meet all College of Liberal Arts requirements in order to be considered for admission (minimum of 24 graded transferable hours, with at least a 2.75 GPA at the time of application).

Transfer applicants should have completed a full semester course load of 12 transferable hours (minimum) after graduating from high school.
