Additional Information

- Students must have a strong interest in teaching secondary Agricultural Science. This is expressed through the essay portion of the application.
- The AGSC degree program includes all requirements for secondary teacher certification in Agriculture, Food and Natural Resources for grades 6-12.
- A semester of student teaching is a required component of the degree plan.
- Teacher certification in the state of Texas does have specific grade requirements once students begin coursework at Texas A&M. Upon admission, please visit with an advisor to ensure all requirements are met.
- Meeting with an academic advisor in this department is strongly recommended prior to application.
- Please contact department regarding second-choice major consideration before applying.
