Any two courses listed above will satisfy this requirement.

The six (6) credits of math, listed above, must be completed before applications will be considered. MATH 2413 and MATH 2414 are accepted in lieu of MATH 1324 and MATH 1325.

Repeated courses will also be used in the GPA calculation. Example: If an applicant makes an F in ENGL 1301, then repeats ENGL 1301 and makes an A, the A and the F both will be used in the GPA calculation.

A grade of 'D' is considered passing; however, a grade of 'D' negatively impacts the GPA.

Transfer Course Sheet Notes

- Admission preference is given to applicants with the highest GPA, appropriate essay content, and the most appropriate courses completed.
- ENGL 1301 is accepted for ENGL 104 if completed prior to Fall 2014.
- MATH 1324 from some institutions will not be a direct equivalent to MATH 141 at Texas A&M University but will satisfy the core math requirement for this major.
- This Transfer Course Sheet was supported in a partnership between the Office of Admissions and the College of Agriculture & Life Sciences at Texas A&M University with the Undergraduate Catalog having the most extant and definitive information.

Additional Transfer Requirements

- Having completed the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.
- 2.5 overall GPA on 24 transferrable hours (minimum).
- To be considered for admission, applicants must have completed 6 credits of approved mathematics (see left).
- To be considered for admission applicants must submit an essay(s) articulating:
 - What is your passion?
 - How did you get it?
 - What is/are your career goal(s)?
 - Why did you choose RPTS/How can RPTS help you reach your career goals?
 - If your GPA is 2.8 or below, explain how being in RPTS will improve your academic record

- Meeting with an academic advisor is strongly recommended prior to application.
- Please contact department regarding second-choice major consideration before applying.
