- Admission preference is given to applicants with the highest GPA and the most appropriate courses completed.

Additional Transfer Requirements

- 2.75 GPA on 24 hours of graded transferable coursework (minimum).
- Students with a GPA below 2.75 but at or above 2.5 may also be considered on a case by case basis.

- An additional University Studies application may also be required from the College of Education & Human Development, see appropriate messaging when submitting the application on ApplyTexas.
