- 2.5 GPA or better with 18 graded transferable hours (minimum).
- Fall and spring admission preferred.

Additional Information

- If the student does not have two years of high school foreign language, they must take two semesters of the same language in college.
- Note: All license option programs require three summer cruises. Student must have a minimum of one semester in residence prior to first cruise. For all transfer students, license option degrees will require three years of residency.
