Additional Transfer Requirements:

In addition to applying to Texas A&M University at Galveston, ALL MART & LICENSE OPTION students MUST also apply and be accepted into Texas A&M Maritime Academy - Regiment of Midshipmen (formerly Corps of Cadets).

Additional Information:

- For Fall enrollment, sign up for a New Student or Transfer Student Conference during the summer prior to starting classes. Students will be advised and registered for classes at the conference.
- For Spring enrollment, sign up for the Transfer Student Conference scheduled for the week prior to classes beginning in January. Transfer students will be advised and registered for classes at the conference.

Transfer Course Sheet Notes

1. ENGL 1301 is accepted for ENGL 104 if completed prior to Fall 2014.
2. Admission preference is given to applicants with the highest GPA and the most appropriate courses completed.

Additional Transfer Requirements

- 2.5 GPA or better with 24 graded transferable hours (minimum).
- Fall and spring admission preferred.

Additional Information

- If the student does not have two years of high school foreign language, they must take two semesters of the same language.
- Note: All license option programs require successful completion of three training cruises. Student must have a minimum of one semester in residence prior to first cruise (in addition to successful completion of the following course pre-requisites: MART 103, MART 203, MART 204, and MART 201. For all transfer students, license option degrees will require minimum of three years' residency.
