#### Coursework Timeline

- Applications to the summer/fall term **may** be asked to submit spring final grades. Competitive applicants will have Recommended and Required coursework completed by the application deadline.
- Summer coursework **will not** be considered for summer/fall applicants.
- Fall coursework **will not** be considered for spring applicants.
- Applicants to the spring term should have the Recommended and Required coursework completed by the end of Summer II semester before applying.

#### Additional Transfer Requirements

- Transfer applicants should have completed a full semester (spring or fall) course load of 12 transferable hours (minimum) after graduating from high school.
- Transfer applicants should have no more than 60 hours completed at the time of application. The department strongly recommends that students apply for transfer as early as possible.
- The Department of History is looking for students who are interested in pursuing our degree as a focus. The essay and supporting materials should reflect that the student is interested in pursuing our degree.
- Meeting minimum requirements **does not** guarantee admission. The entire record is reviewed for consistency in coursework and grades.

#### Additional Information

- The Department of History will accept AP/IB and dual credit coursework when applicable. **DO NOT** retake classes for which you have AP/IB/Dual Credit. If you are unsure how your credit may be applied to the degree plan, contact an advisor for the department.
