- Maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA at the system institution
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA overall (including graded, transferable credit earned in high school)
- PSA students can only apply for the fall term. Students will not be eligible to enroll for summer sessions.
