- Consider taking courses that fulfill the 3 hours of [International and Cultural Diversity](#) and/or the 3 hours of [Cultural Discourse](#) requirement when completing the Social and Behavioral Sciences, free electives, and Creative Arts requirements.
- It is highly recommended that a student begins attending TAMU spring semester of the second year due to the course sequence of the special education program. The recommended list of courses for the spring semester of the second year will vary depending on if the student is attending TAMU or still attending a community college. During that semester, there may be limited options of courses to take while at a community college.



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Coursework Timeline

- Competitive applicants will have the Required coursework completed by the application deadline.
- Applicants to the summer/fall term **may be** asked to submit spring final grades, this is not a guarantee.
- Summer coursework **will not** be considered for summer/fall applicants.
- Fall coursework **will not** be considered for spring applicants.
- Applicants to the spring term should have the Required coursework completed by the end of Summer II semester before applying.

Additional Transfer Requirements

- Students should strive to complete both math courses from the list above with grades of 'C' or better.
- The Kinesiology and Sport Management Department is looking for students who are interested in pursuing our degree as a focus. Students should indicate our department as the primary major they are interested in if they wish to be admitted. The essay and supporting materials should reflect that the student is interested in pursuing our degree.
- Meeting minimum requirements **does not** guarantee admission. The entire record is reviewed for consistency in coursework and grades.

Additional Information

- Applicants should be serious about earning a degree in Sport Management as indicated by their first-choice major preference on the Apply Texas Transfer Application.
- Transfer applicants are instructed **NOT** to accept transfer admission to any major with the expectation of later applying for an on-campus change of major.

Career & Educational Opportunities

This major is for students interested in the study of sports from a business perspective with the goal of entering the sport industry. Additionally, students may be interested in pursuing careers as administrators and managers in athletic, health, and country clubs, as well as entry-level management positions in college and professional athletic organizations.
