- In addition to meeting the academic preferences for transfer consideration into the Theatre program, applicants must also submit a 300-word Artist Statement illustrating:
 - Applicant interest in creating new and original works of theatre using devising methods.
 - Demonstrated collaboration with a wide variety of peers.
 - Applicant creative and professional goals in the context of our curriculum.
- Transfer applicants should have completed 24 hours of coursework.
- Students should strive to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater on all college courses that transfer to TAMU.
- The Theatre program is looking for students who are interested in pursuing our degree as a focus. The essay and supporting materials should reflect that the student is interested in pursuing our degree.
- Meeting minimum requirements **does not** guarantee admission. The entire record is reviewed for consistency in coursework and grades.



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Additional Information

- Transfer applicants are instructed **NOT** to accept transfer admission to any major with the expectation of later applying for an on-campus change of major.

The Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in Theatre at Texas A&M prepares you for careers onstage, backstage and offstage. Students in the BFA will create and produce theatrical works developed using collaborative creation and devising techniques for public presentation, analyze social and cultural contexts in the development of theatrical works, lead with consent-forward practices in theatrical collaborations, and appraise aesthetic choices in performance design, dramaturgy, and directing.

Through this program you will become a flexible and innovative creator who can communicate across cultures and media, and who thrives in a highly varied and ever-changing job market. Theatre majors go on to be directors, actors, designers, technicians, stage managers, and theatre teachers.
