- In addition to meeting the academic preferences for transfer consideration into the Theatre program, applicants must also submit a 300-word Artist Statement illustrating:
  - Applicant interest in creating new and original works of theatre using devising methods.
  - Demonstrated collaboration with a wide variety of peers.
  - Applicant creative and professional goals in the context of our curriculum.
- Transfer applicants should have completed 24 hours of coursework.
- Students should strive to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or greater on all college courses that transfer to TAMU.
- The Theatre program is looking for students who are interested in pursuing our degree as a focus. Students should indicate our program as the primary major they are interested in if they wish to be admitted. The essay and supporting materials should reflect that the student is interested in pursuing our degree.
- Meeting minimum requirements **does not** guarantee admission. The entire record is reviewed for consistency in coursework and grades.
