To qualify for automatic admission through PTA, a student must:

- Students MUST graduate high school before they are eligible to sign up for PTA
- Complete 30 consecutive hours after high school graduation in residency at any Texas community college or a combination of Texas community colleges
- A grade of B or better must be earned on **bold**, **italicized** coursework on the first attempt.
- Participants are allowed a maximum of three withdrawals (W's) throughout their college career with a maximum of one withdrawal (W) per **bold, italicized** course.
- Maintain a minimum 3.2 cumulative GPA (including graded, transferable credit earned in high school)
- Attend a mandatory meeting with a Texas A&M admissions counselor and follow ALL PTA guidelines
- Submit all other <u>required documents</u> (application fee, transcripts, essay, etc.) by the appropriate deadline for admission to Texas A&M University
